

Will at least one marshal at each point wear a marshal jacket for safety and to help the motorcycle marshal identify the official to save his time.

Please mark your start sheets as each rider passed with the time if possible. A mobile marshal will keep you informed of the progress of the first and last riders. Marshals will be advised when to affect cut-outs.

Notes to Timekeepers

Please report to the Master Timekeeper at the start of the circuit at 2.30 for 3 pm. The rendezvous is at the event headquarters at the junction with the lane to High Halden. Please arrange for a recorder and bring a watch if you can. Mark on your timekeeping sheet those riders who stop at your station and return your sheet to the Master Timekeeper at the start of the circuit as soon as possible after the finish.

Endeavour to stop riders from continuing when they have completed their ride and try to give them an idea of the distance they have covered. You will be advised of riders who have lost distance around the route.

Notes to helpers and spectators

A progress and result board will be used throughout the day and will show 50 and 100 mile times where appropriate. It will show the progress of riders around the circuit by indicating time left to run as each rider passes the Master Timekeeper.

Please do not bother timekeepers, the person completing the result board will welcome advice regarding non-finishers and actual finishing stops.

The promoters acknowledge help offered which we are confident will ensure the same high standard and friendly spirit of the event that has become a hallmark of the KCA 12. A happy and successful day to you all.

Notes for Riders

Please note carefully the position of the start which is also the start of the circuit. This can be reached by taking the A.247 at Maidstone and turning left at Bletchenden cross roads, approx 1 mile south of Headcorn.

Cars may be parked on the verges of the lane leading to down towards High Hadden, beyond the notice and frontage to farmhouse.

Please leave time to fix your number. The event starts punctually, please avoid a late start as it complicates timekeeping excessively,

A copy of the route and feeding arrangements are enclosed The following cut-outs may be used for slower riders:-

1. New Romney-Dungeness-New Romney 10.729 mls
2. Charing Roundabout-Caves Cafe-Charing 17.612 mls
3. Ashford-Chilham-Ashford 16.910 mls
4. Staplehurst-Pike Fish Farm-Staplehurst 23.070 mls
5. Claygate-Pike Fish Farm-Claygate 11.448 mls

It is hoped all riders will be back on the circuit with time to complete one circuit. This means several slower riders will be cut off legs especially for Claygate and Staplehurst. Please be prepared to adjust schedules accordingly.

Notes to Marshalls

You are requested to indicate the direction to be followed by riders but not to hold up traffic which is an offence under the law.
