

Notes on Marshalls

You are requested to indicate the direction to be followed by the riders but not to hold up traffic which is an offence under the law.

If possible, wear a marshall's jacket (either one available at the start, or use your own club jacket), as these will help the marshals, the riders and other road users to know there is a race on. You will be informed of the progress of first and last riders, also when to affect cut-outs when necessary.

Notes to Timekeepers

Please report to the Master Timekeeper at the start of the circuit at 2.30 for 3pm. The rendezvous is at the event headquarters at the junction with the lane to High Halden. Please arrange for a recorder and bring a watch if you can. Mark on your timekeeping sheet those riders who stop at your station and return your sheet to the Master Timekeeper at the start of the circuit as soon as possible after the finish.

Endeavour to stop riders from continuing when they have completed their ride and try to give them an idea of the distance they have covered. You will be advised of riders who have lost distance around the route.

Notes to helpers and spectators

A progress and result board will be used throughout the day and will show 50 and 100 mile times where appropriate. It will show the progress of riders around the circuit by indicating time left to run as each rider passes the Master Timekeeper.

Please do not bother timekeepers, the person completing the result board will welcome advice regarding non-finishers and actual finishing stops.

The promoters acknowledge help offered which we are confident will ensure the same high standard and friendly spirit of the event that has become a hallmark of the KCA12. A happy and successful day to you all.

Headquarters which will house car park, result board, toilets and refreshments will be in Bethersden Village Hall. This must be used by all participating in any way with the event. No parking at all at the start or around the verges of roads near the start.

Notes for riders

Please note carefully the position of the start which is also the start of the circuit. This can be reached by taking the A.247 at Maidstone and turning left at Bletchenden cross roads, approx 1 mile south of Headcorn.

Cars must be parked in the headquarters at Bethersden village hall.

When your 12 hours have expired you must carry on to the next timekeeper in order that your correct distance can be calculated. Do not follow riders in cars, and do not pass food or drink to riders while travelling. Do ~~take~~ note of all RTTC rules. Official observers will be on the course throughout the day. The event starts punctually please avoid a late start as it complicates timekeeping excessively. A copy of the route and feeding arrangements are enclosed. It is hoped all riders will be back on the circuit with time to complete one circuit. This means slower riders will be cut off legs during the day.
