To reach the start from the H.Q. - turn right on the A28 to the Bethersden Bull P.H.. Turn right at the "Bull" and the start is approximately 930 yards westward at the fir tree, 20 yards west of the entrance to Buckhall Farm. ALLOW 15 MINUTES TO COLLECT AND FIX NUMBERS WHICH WILL BE AT THE START.

Committee will disqualify any rider guilty of infringing regulation No. 52 (which is on page 75 of the R.T.T.C. handbook). Please read this and ensure that your driver understands the restrictions of this regulation.

NOTES

Marshals

Indicate the direction to be followed in a positive manner but **DO NOT HOLD UP THE TRAFFIC.**

If possible wear a marshal's jacket or some bright clothing. There will be some marshalling jackets at the event HQ at Bethersden Village Hall. If you borrow a jacket please either hand it to your relief or return it to the hall. Please return marshal's check sheets to Event Organiser or Roving Marshal.

Timekeepers

Report to the master Timekeeper at the Bull Inn Bethersden at 2.15pm. Please bring a watch and arrange for a recorder to accompany you.

Helpers and Spectators

Once again I must remind you to ensure that your helpers are conversant with R.T.T.C. regulation No. 52.

A result board will be at H.Q. and will show 50 and 100 miles times where appropriate. Do not bother the Timekeepers. Derek Lamb who will be completing the result board will welcome information regarding non-finishers.

Riders

Do remember that the start has altered from last years event.

You must observe R.T.T.C regulation No 51.

When you finish make sure your helpers do not obscure the Timekeeper's view or impede other riders.
