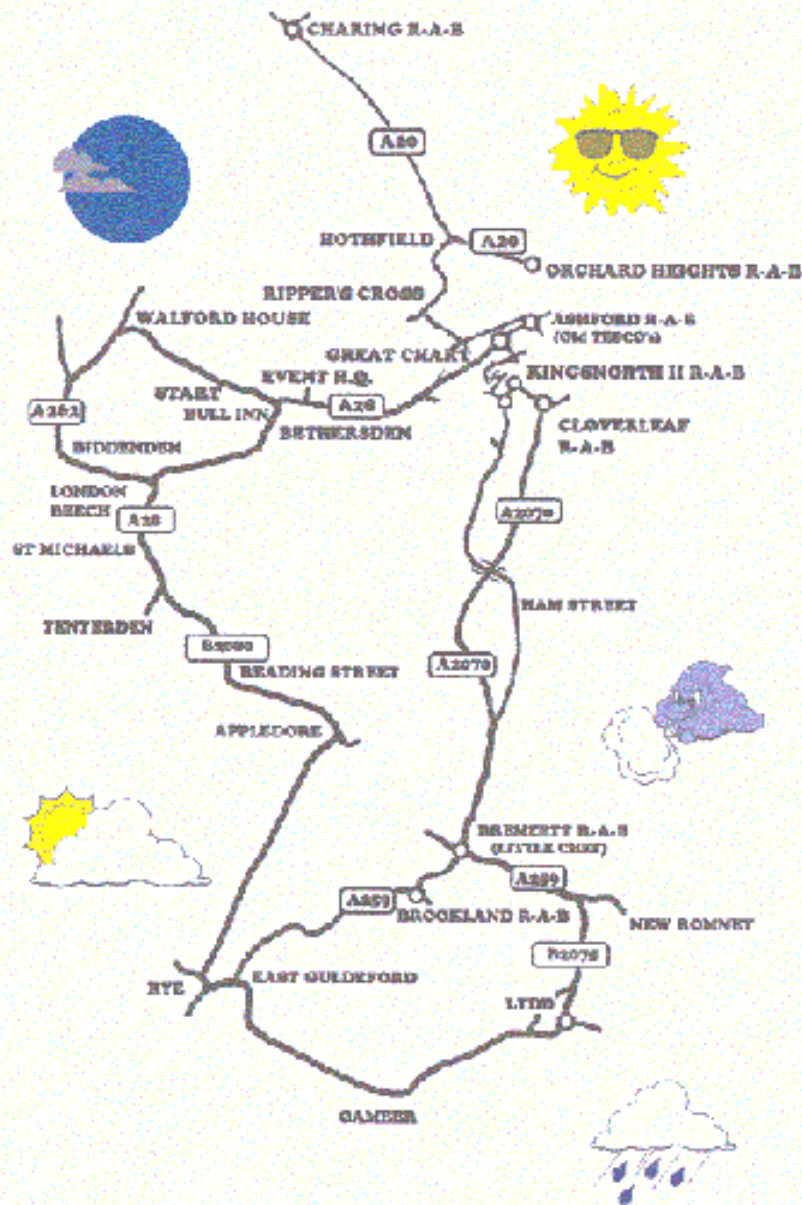

NOTES

Riders

The course is the same as last year, although there have been some minor changes to the road layouts between Stanhope R-A-B and Tithe Barn Lane. You should note that there WILL NOT be marshals at every junction, but it is intended, as in previous years, to place direction arrows around the course. However YOU are responsible for ensuring that you follow the course correctly. TAKE EXTRA CARE at the RIGHT TURNS.

Tricycle riders should note that they will not turn left at the Bull Inn Bethersden, but will omit this circuit and go straight to Singleton round-a-bout. This will reduce their mileage by 13.310 miles.

To reach the start from the H.Q. turn right toward the A28 and then right to the Bethersden Bull P.H. where turn right.

You must observe R.T.T.C. Regulation No 49.

Forms are enclosed so that you can register your support vehicle. Note well that the K.C.A. Committee will disqualify any rider guilty of infringing regulation No 50 (which is on page 104 of the R.T.T.C. handbook). Please read this and ensure that your driver understands the restrictions of this regulation.

All Support Vehicles are to Turn Left at Coleman Green T Junction and rejoin the old A2070. They Must Not Turn Right.

When you finish make sure your helpers do not obscure the Timekeeper's view or impede other riders. Please note that NO Riders or Vehicles are to stop at Timekeeper number 9. Riders whose time expires at this point must continue to a safe and convenient stopping point.

A result board will be at the event H.Q. and will show 50, and 100 mile times where appropriate. Do not bother the Timekeepers. Information regarding non finishers will be welcomed.

The K.C.A. wishes all competitors a safe and enjoyable ride.

Cut Out Legs

Those riding Tricycles will omit the circuit of the Bull Inn Bethersden - Walford House - Newcastle Farm - London Beech - Bull Inn Bethersden of 13.310 miles

Slower riders will omit one or more of the following legs. The circuit from Park Farm round-a-bout to Brenzett (Little Chef) will close at 2.15pm. The circuit from Ashford (old Tesco's) round-a-bout to Charing round-a-bout and return will close at 3.15 pm.

1. No 2nd circuit from Park Farm, Ham Street, Brenzett (Little Chef), Cloverleaf round-a-bout 21.397 Miles
2. No 3rd circuit from Park Farm, Ham Street, Brenzett (Little Chef) Cloverleaf round-a-bout 21.397 Miles
3. Turn at Ashford (old Tesco's) round-a-bout after 3.15pm and omit Great Chart, Charing round-a-bout, Orchard Heights round-a-bout, Hothfield, Great Chart 18.281 Miles
