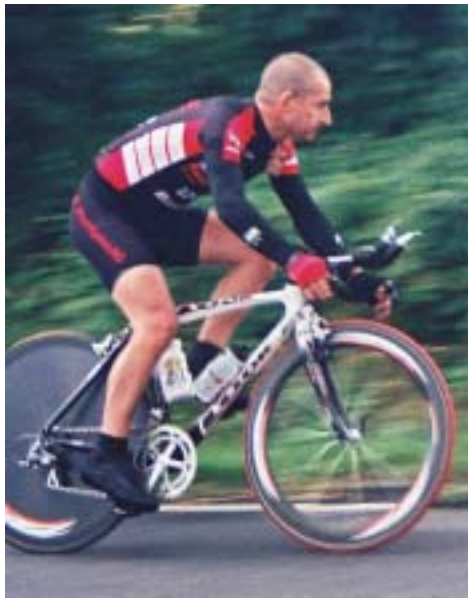

Keith raised the level of excitement on the finishing circuit as he lapped at increasing speed in an effort to make up time lost with punctures.

Bob Harber and Anthony Reeves made a return trip to Kent and improved on last year's mileages to take best improvement awards. Clint Maisey was third in this category in spite of shoulder problems and a nasty fall. Phil Saynor took the vets award from his training partner John Booty. Barry Charlton snatched third place vet from Gary Chalkley after a recount. Dick Bradley deserves a mention as he celebrated the very first '12' he rode fifty years ago, this time accumulating 190 miles! There were no trikes this year but the Knott/Meacen tandem did a fine ride and have hinted that they will have another go next year.
