



NOTES

Riders

In the interests of your own safety, the C.T.T. and the event promoters strongly advise the use of a hard shell helmet that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

The Course has been changed this year. It consists of three circuits. Brenzett - East Guldeford - Lydd - Brenzett; Brenzett - Appledore - Rye - Brenzett; and Brenzett - Ham Street - Magpie Hall Lane - New Street Farm - Tenterden - Appledore - Brenzett. It no longer includes the circuit around Ivychurch and NewChurch. You should note that there will not be marshals at every junction, but it is intended to place arrows around the course. However, You are responsible for ensuring that you follow the course correctly. Take Extra CARE at the RIGHT TURNS.

To reach the start from the H.Q. turn right toward the A28 and then right to the Bethersden Bull P.H. where turn right.

Riders should be aware that they risk disqualification for obstructing other riders at the start or on the finishing circuit or using these areas as a public toilet. Toilet facilities are available at the Event H.Q.

Riders should be aware that there is a Road Race planned between 9.30 a.m. and 1.30 p.m.. The road race will use part of the course between Tenterden through Redding Street to the T junction just north of Appledore. (The Road Race turns left). The Road Race HQ is at Woodchurch.

You must observe C.T.T. Regulation No 21.

Forms are enclosed so that you can register your support vehicle. The K.C.A. Committee will disqualify any rider guilty of infringing <u>C.T.T. Regulation No 22</u>. Attention is drawn specifically to paragraph (c) which states:

Where vehicles are to be authorised a full description of the vehicle and registration number shall be given to the event promoter prior to the start of the competitor. <u>A competitor shall not be overtaken by his support vehicle more frequently than once every 10 miles.</u> Where possible the vehicle must be driven at normal traffic speed and <u>must not follow the competitor, nor impede or annoy other competitors</u>. Any competitor whose authorised vehicle impedes or causes annoyance to any other competitor shall be liable to disqualification from the event.

Where any other vehicle precedes or follows for any length of time, or frequently passes a competitor, that vehicle shall be deemed to be associated with that competitor who shall be liable to disqualification from the event.

Please read this and ensure that your driver understands the restrictions of this regulation.

Support Vehicles on the circuit should take extreme care to avoid obstructing riders as there are sections of the circuit that are very narrow. No support vehicles are to travel on the circuit between Brissenden Green and Stubbs Cross. No individual helpers are to park or operate within 300 yards of any circuit timekeeper.

When you finish make sure your helpers do not obscure the Timekeeper's view or impede other riders. Please note that NO Riders or Vehicles are to stop at the Timekeepers, but they must continue to a safe and convenient stopping point.

Please ensure you are conversant with <u>C.T.T. Regulation 25</u>. You are reminded all riders currently using an <u>inhaler for medical reasons</u> should register this fact with British Cycling to satisfy U.C.I., C.T.T. and B.C. anti-doping regulations

A result board will be at the event H.Q. which will show provisional distances. Do not bother the Timekeepers. Information regarding non finishers will be welcomed.

Timekeepers should report to the junction on the A28 at Gable Hook Farm (start of the circuit) at 3.00 p.m. to synchronize watches and be allocated Time Keeper stations.
