At first I was disappointed that no-one from Southboro' Wheelers had entered but David Steel told me in a phone call that he had ridden the KCA 12 in the seventies. A quick look in the archive revealed the information that I did have a Southboro' entry, albeit from a long lost member.

Familiar faces were seen around the course at roundabouts and corners, supplementing the many signs that Tim & James had put out the previous two days.. Early helpers were James & Barney Carpenter at Matalan r.a.b. and New Street Farm and Maurice at the end of Magpie Hall Lane. Gordon Davies and Tony Hall were at Kingsnorth and Park Farm whilst Ann Burden directed riders down to John Clarey and Ray Harrad at Cloverleaf, they in turn saw everyone safely onto the marsh. Tony Farmer was yet again officiating at the first of the many circuits incorporating Brenzett r.a.b. to be helped by Maurice as the division of riders became necessary. Other top guns in the world of long distance time trialling – David Shepherd, Paul Holdsworth, Brian Walker, Colin Parkinson and Andy Miles upheld their reputations all finishing with totals exceeding 250 miles. 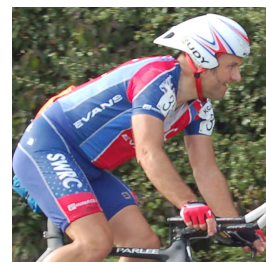

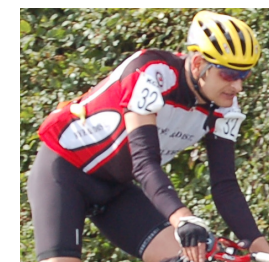

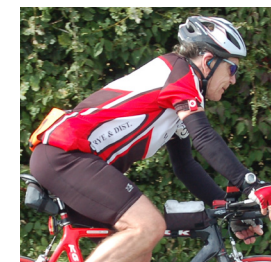
