

Please note that CTT Regulation 16 states that the number shall be centrally positioned below the waist so as to be clearly visible from the rear when in his normal riding position. Position number as shown



Please note that any rider whose number is not positioned correctly will not be allowed to start.

RIDERS

In the interests of your own safety, the C.T.T. and the event promoters strongly advise the use of a hard shell helmet that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

It is the responsibility of each competitor who will be riding on the public highway before sunrise and finishing after sunset to ensure they have the appropriate lighting. Detailed information is available from the CTC web site.

The K.C.A committee recommend All riders carry LED rear lights.

Please take great care when navigating round-a-bouts. Riders should take careful note of the changes to the course, especially around Park Farm and Kingsnorth which now includes additional roundabouts. Two Park Farm circuits will be completed before joining the A2070 via Cloverleaf roundabout to proceed to Brenzett roundabout and the Camber circuit.

You should note that there will not be marshals at every junction, but it is intended to place arrows around the course. However, You are responsible for ensuring that you follow the course correctly. Take Extra CARE at the RIGHT TURNS.

To reach the start from the H.Q. turn right from Bethersden Village Hall toward the A28 and then left on the A28 toward Ashford. Kiln Lane is the first turning on the left.

Riders should be aware that they risk disqualification for obstructing other riders at the start or on the finishing circuit or using these areas as a public toilet. Toilet facilities are available at the Event H.Q.

You must observe C.T.T. Regulation No 21.

Forms are enclosed so that you can register your support vehicle. The K.C.A. Committee will disqualify any rider guilty of infringing C.T.T. Regulation No 22. Attention is drawn specifically to paragraph (c) which states:

Where vehicles are to be authorised a full description of the vehicle and registration number shall be given to the event promoter prior to the start of the competitor. A competitor shall not be overtaken by his support vehicle more frequently than once every 10 miles. Where possible the vehicle must be driven at normal traffic speed and must not follow the competitor, nor impede or annoy other competitors. Any competitor whose authorised vehicle impedes or causes annoyance to any other

Where any other vehicle precedes or follows for any length of time, or frequently passes a competitor, that vehicle shall be deemed to be associated with that competitor who shall be liable to disgualification from the event.

Please read this and ensure that your driver understands the restrictions of this regulation.

Support Vehicles on the circuit should take extreme care to avoid obstructing riders as there are sections of the circuit that are very narrow. No individual helpers are to park or operate within 300 yards of any circuit timekeeper.

When you finish make sure your helpers do not obscure the Timekeeper's view or impede other riders. Please note that NO Riders or Vehicles are to stop at the Timekeepers, but they must continue to a safe and convenient stopping point.

Please ensure you are conversant with C.T.T. Regulation 25.

A result board will be at the event H.Q. which will show provisional distances. Do not bother the Timekeepers. Information regarding non finishers will be welcomed.

The K.C.A. wishes all competitors a safe and enjoyable ride.

CUT OUT LEGS

Slower riders will omit Brenzett - East Guldeford - Camber - Lydd - Hammonds Corner - Brenzett circuits if necessary

The Ivychurch - St Mary's - Newchurch - Ivychurch circuit will close at Ivychurch at 3.30 p.m.

FEEDING ARRANGEMENTS

There will be no feed during the event. Food and drink for unsupported riders will be taken to Brenzett round-a-bout, and then moved to Ivychurch during the event. Please make sure that you leave clearly marked containers at the signing on position.

MARSHALS

Indicate the direction to be followed in a positive manner but Do Not Hold Up The Traffic.

Please wear a marshal's jacket. There will be jackets at the event H.Q. at Bethersden Village Hall. If you borrow a jacket please either hand it to your relief or return it to the hall. Please return marshal's check sheets to the Event Organizer or the Roving Marshal.

TIMEKEEPERS

Timekeepers should report to Kings Head, Shadoxhurst at 2.30 p.m. to synchronise watches and be allocated Time Keeper stations.

MASSAGE

We are lucky that Jackie has brought her massage table to the 12 Hour for several years and she'll be there again this year. It's a popular feature of the event and we'd like to suggest that you donate a minimum of $\mathfrak{L}5$ to her to cover the cost of her oils, etc.

COURSE Q12 (2011)

Due to road works on the canal road between Appledore and Rye the course has been changed substantially this year.

The course around Park Farm and Kingsnorth now includes additional round-a-bouts, and riders will complete a new circuit from Park Farm round-a-bout through Bromley Green, Sugar Loaf cross roads to the top of Ham Street Hill where they turn left to join the A2070 northwards through Bridgefield round-a-bout to Cloverleaf round-a-bout where left to Kingsnorth 2 round-a-bout and left to Park Farm round-a-bout. When riders have completed this part of the course they will turn at Park Farm to join the A2070 southbound through the Cloverleaf round-a-bout, Bridgefield round-a-bout to Brenzett round-a-bout.

Please note the finishing circuit is also different this year. The circuit starts at Sugar Loaf and goes to Magpie Hall Cross Roads where left to Stubbs Cross where left through Shadoxhurst to Coldblow where riders turn left to return to Sugar Loaf cross roads where they turn left to the start of the circuit.

The KCA committee recommend Riders to carry LED rear lights for use in the wooded areas of the course.

Please take great care when navigating round-a-bouts.
