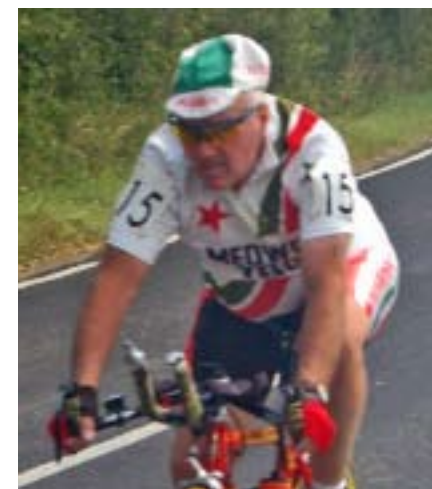
One from the Archives - In 2002 Riders had to contend with Cows on the circuit at Coldblow. Peter Holland seems pleased at the diversion!

2012 Report

The Summer of 2012 will be remembered by most people for strong wind throughout and its best friend, torrential rain. Week after week result sheets showed unprecedented numbers of DNFs and DNSs and I couldn't help wondering what September would bring. I realised, as a steady stream of entries hit my doormat from February onwards, that long-distance cyclists are an optimistic lot and by the closing date sixty seven entries had been received – the most for many years.

September 2nd turned out to be a perfect, early Autumn day, cool but not cold, wind but no gales and sunshine for most of the day. Early on, Andy Miles, Carl Chapman and Lawrence Wintergold were flamboyantly eating up the miles on the marsh followed more circumspectly by Shay Giles, Ishmael Burdeau, Matt Coombs and Peter Morris. Lewes Wanderers had made the journey to Kent to break their long-standing club 12 hour team record and it was a blow when Tom Glandfield climbed off before completing 100 miles after lying third at 50. Nick Wilson and Steve Gooch, both Rye Wheelers, were also among the fancied riders who packed before arriving at the 100 mile timekeeper.

Lawrence Wintergold's problems started when his chain came off and jammed and more trouble followed when he broke the clip on his bar extension losing half of his bars at 150 miles and the other half on the finishing circuit together with the gear cables which ran through the bars. Disaster struck Andy Miles, who hasn't had a trouble-free ride in any of his twelves, when the engine in his support car blew up. Luckily club mate Brian Birch was on the course and was able to take over but it was a worrying time for him. There were a few DNSs, notably Alec Mayes, – last of the Bishop/Mackey/Mayes triumvirate – who wasn't well although he and Linda were both out on the course supporting Ray Firth. Alec looked peaky but a happy smile lit up his face when he realised he could ride next year. Although John Bishop is no longer with us his son, Stephen, rode the event once more and even better, Pam Bishop turned up in her traditional spot at Brookland and joined the group of spectators at the roundabout.
