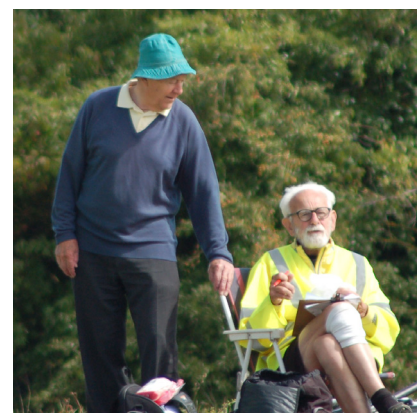

A BRIEF ACCOUNT

This year we had a record entry for the event. Earlier in the week Peter Stone had reported that there were no spectacular hazards on the route and this was confirmed on Saturday by Tim when he put the signs out. Lastly, the weather forecast was good. I lay in bed the night before thinking that this could be the perfect 12 - my ambition for years. Alas, it was not to be but overall the results were excellent.

We had seven riders amassing more than 250 miles each and sixteen in total beat evens. The overall winner, Michael Barnes, missed out on the record for being the youngest ever winner. San Fairy Ann's Tim Warren who won the event in 1983 was younger by several months but it was a wonderful effort by Michael in a very competitive field. Lewes Wanderers made sure of the team prize again and Shay Giles takes the Vets award once more. Peter Hooper had a massive twenty five mile improvement to win the award in that category.

Peter Holland rode round on his trike and claimed 138 miles for last place. The 12 hour was his convalescence but not recommended for everybody.
